

# WYOMING STATE P.E.O. SCHOLARSHIPS

## Scholarship Descriptions

1. Wyoming Cottey College Scholarship – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded on academic achievement, leadership, character, participation in both extracurricular and out-of-school activities, and financial need; and is paid directly to Cottey College.
2. Wyoming B.I.L. Cottey College Continuing Education Fund – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate and a current second year student at Cottey College, with plans to continue her education at Cottey College or another accredited institution. The grant shall be awarded based on academic and personal achievements at Cottey College, and on financial need.
3. Leona S. Donley Scholarship – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted at Cottey College, with preference given to the top-ranking Natrona County applicant. Otherwise, preference will be given to the top-ranking second, third or fourth year Cottey College applicant from Natrona County. Should there be no applicants from Natrona County, the scholarship shall be awarded to the top Cottey student from Wyoming. The scholarship shall be awarded based on academic achievement, leadership, character, participation in both extra-curricular and out-of-school activities, and financial need.
4. Jeanette Ord Sager Cottey College Scholarship – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted as a first-year student at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded based on academic achievement, leadership, and financial need.
5. Strube Cottey College Scholarship Fund – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who have been accepted at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded equally to all Wyoming students enrolled at Cottey College.
6. Muriel E. Spacht Scholarship – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted at a college of her choice as a first-, second-, third-, or fourth-year student.
7. Carol W. and William R. Daley Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a female graduate or undergraduate student accepted to the University of Wyoming, with preference given to international and non-traditional women students, and with consideration of financial need.
8. Glen Ella Jones Scholarship – Applicants shall be female Wyoming residents 21 years of age or older, who have graduated from high school or have earned a High School Equivalency Certificate. This scholarship is intended to assist women who have no college credits, or who have earned some college credits but have not completed a degree. It may be used at any two- or four-year college or university, including nationally accredited vocational schools. The scholarship shall be awarded based on educational goals, career plans, and financial need.
9. Karen F. Lippincott Scholarship – Applicants shall be female Wyoming residents, who have graduated from high school or have earned a High School Equivalency Certificate. Applicants may have some college credits, or be a first-year student with no credits. Applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a local P.E.O. chapter. The scholarship may be used at any two- or four-year college or university, including nationally accredited vocational schools, to which the applicant has been accepted. The scholarship shall be awarded based on educational goals, career plans, and financial need.
10. Grace N. Brown Scholarship Fund – Awards shall be made to women residing in Wyoming who have financial need and have demonstrated concern for others.

## Applicant Instructions

You can apply for multiple scholarships with this one application, however different information and requirements pertain to each scholarship. For example, a letter of recommendation from an instructor for one scholarship can be used as one of the additional, non-specific letters of recommendation for another scholarship.

### Wyoming Cottey College Scholarship

The scholarship packet must be submitted to the sponsoring P.E.O. chapter by **January 5**.

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- A high school transcript, including ACT, PSAT or SAT scores (*Please provide conversions scale from letter to numeric grades*) for 1<sup>st</sup> year student **OR** a Cottey College transcript for continuing Cottey students
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- One letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor, teacher or professor
- Up to two additional letters of recommendations may be added

### Wyoming BIL Cottey College Continuing Education Scholarship

The scholarship packet must be submitted to the sponsoring P.E.O. chapter by **January 5**.

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- A Cottey College transcript
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- One letter of recommendation from an instructor
- Up to two additional letters of recommendation

### Leona S. Donley Cottey College Scholarship

The scholarship packet must be submitted to the sponsoring P.E.O. chapter by **January 5**.

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- A high school transcript, including ACT, PSAT or SAT scores (*Please provide conversions scale from letter to numeric grades*) for 1<sup>st</sup> year student **OR** a Cottey College transcript for continuing Cottey students
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- One letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor, teacher or professor
- Up to two additional letters of recommendations may be added

### Jeanette Ord Sager Cottey College Scholarship

The scholarship packet must be submitted to the sponsoring P.E.O. chapter by **January 5**.

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- One letter of recommendation from an advisor or professor
- Up to two additional letters of recommendation

## **Carol W. and William R. Daley Memorial Scholarship**

The scholarship packet must be submitted to the sponsoring P.E.O. chapter by **January 5**.

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- One letter of recommendation from an instructor. If student is a college senior or graduate student, the current instructor should be in the student's major field
- Up to two additional letters of recommendations may be added

The packet must include:

- This completed application, including the additional information as outlined on page 5
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
