WYOMING STATE P.E.O. SCHOLARSHIPS Cottey College Scholarship Descriptions

Read the scholarship descriptions below to determine eligibility.

- 1. Wyoming Cottey College Scholarship Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted or is enrolled at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded on academic achievement, leadership, character, participation in both extracurricular and out-of-school activities, and financial need. Scholarship paid directly to Cottey College.
- 2. Wyoming B.I.L. Cottey College Continuing Education Fund Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate and a current second year student at Cottey College, with plans to continue her education at Cottey College or another accredited institution. The grant shall be awarded based on academic and personal achievements at Cottey College, and on financial need.
- 3. Leona S. Donley Scholarship Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted at Cottey College, with preference given to the top-ranking Natrona County applicant. Otherwise, preference will be given to the top-ranking second, third or fourth year Cottey College applicant from Natrona County. Should there be no applicants from Natrona County, the scholarship shall be awarded to the top Cottey student from Wyoming. The scholarship shall be awarded based on academic achievement, leadership, character, participation in both extracurricular and out-of school activities, and financial need.
- 4. Jeanette Ord Sager Cottey College Scholarship Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted as a first-year student at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded based on academic achievement, leadership, and financial need.
- 5. Strube Cottey College Scholarship Fund Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who have been accepted at Cottey College. The scholarship shall be awarded equally to all Wyoming students enrolled at Cottey College.
