

WYOMING STATE P.E.O. SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Descriptions

Scholarships for students not applying to Cottey College

1. Muriel E. Spacht Scholarship – Applicant must be a Wyoming resident who has graduated from a Wyoming high school or has earned a High School Equivalency Certificate, who has been accepted at a college of her choice as a first-, second-, third-, or fourth-year student.
2. Carol W. and William R. Daley Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a female graduate or undergraduate student accepted to the University of Wyoming, with preference given to international and non-traditional women students, and with consideration of financial need.
3. Glen Ella Jones Scholarship – Applicants shall be female Wyoming residents **21 years of age or older**, who have graduated from high school or have earned a High School Equivalency Certificate. This scholarship is intended to assist women who have no college credits, or who have earned some college credits but have not completed a degree. It may be used at any two- or four-year college or university, including nationally accredited vocational schools. The scholarship shall be awarded based on educational goals, career plans, and financial need.
4. Karen F. Lippincott Scholarship – Applicants shall be female Wyoming residents, who have graduated from high school or have earned a High School Equivalency Certificate. Applicants may have some college credits, or be a first-year student with no credits. Applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a local P.E.O. chapter. The scholarship may be used at any two- or four-year college or university, including nationally accredited vocational schools, to which the applicant has been accepted. The scholarship shall be awarded based on educational goals, career plans, and financial need.
5. Grace N. Brown Scholarship Fund – Awards shall be made to women residing in Wyoming who have financial need and have demonstrated concern for others.

- It is not necessary to duplicate materials that can fulfill requirements for multiple scholarships. For example, a letter of recommendation from an instructor can be used to fulfill the same requirement for another scholarship or be used as one of the additional, non-specific letters of recommendation for another scholarship.
- **Write on each letter of recommendation the scholarship(s) to which it applies.**
- Do not include more than one transcript. Do not use covers or binders.

Muriel E. Spacht Scholarship

The packet must include:

- One letter of recommendation from an advisor or professor
- Up to two additional letters of recommendation
- Unofficial transcript

Carol W. and William R. Daley Memorial Scholarship

The packet must include:

- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- One letter of recommendation from an instructor. If student is a college senior or graduate student, the current instructor should be in the student's major field
- Up to two additional letters of recommendations may be added
- Unofficial transcript

Glen Ella Jones Scholarship

The packet must include:

- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- Unofficial transcript

Karen F. Lippencott Scholarship

The packet must include:

- A letter of recommendation from a local P.E.O. chapter
- A letter or statement specifying financial need
- Unofficial transcript

Grace N. Brown Scholarship

The packet must include:

- A letter or statement documenting demonstrated concern for others and indicating financial need
- All additional information listed on page 3
- Unofficial transcript
